Dear Pastor and Church members :

Hoping you are enjoying the blessings of our Almighty God, I am writing to let you know about my husbands health.

On May 27th during the evening service my husband was preaching, when he had a heart attack at the beginning of the message he felt he was dying but he continued with the message. Some members realized that something was not right with him, and when I saw him I thought that he was tired from the hard work done during the previous week in the construction of the new work.

We left the cult, we returned home and there he called one of his relatives who is a doctor and ask him to check his blood pressure. My husband, did not tell me how he felt during the service, but when I heard what he had said to the Doctor, I immediately took him to ER, where the electrocardiogram test showed a myocardial infarction, it was immediately attended and ALL THE HONOR AND GLORY to OUR ALMIGHTY GOD because the Doctor said that this type of heart attack 3 of 10 arrive at the hospital. He had a catheterization and he was in ICU four days. He go out of the Hospital on May 31th but on June 2nd he had another heart attack; anew God took care of him and he got over it, the Doctor make him another catheterization and by the Grace of God now he is recovering at home.

I have no words to express my gratitude and my feeling and my commitment to my God, when my husband was preaching he says that he felt a strong pain in his chest, he felt dying and he only said in his mind "Lord, I'm feel dying, I am preaching that we need to go one mile more and I will give that mile, forgive my sins please and I am ready to be in your presence if this is your will"

Since my husband quit his secular job we don't have medical insurance coverage either social security, but we are very thankful because God has been so good and through the years in the ministry we never had need of medical attention until now. When we arrive to the hospital all was fast, the doctor said that my husband was in a critical condition and he needed to be hospitalized. It was needed cover \$ 18,000.00 dollars for all the medical expenses in both event. God has provide \$ 6,000.00 dollars through relatives, friends and Churches. We ask of your prayers for the Lord provide the remain amount. Also we ask of your prayers for my husband's recovering, to work for the Lord is his passion and he wants to press on.
