What a whirlwind these last couple of months has been! We have had the privilege of visiting with a few of you, and we have also had a chance to visit some of our own extended family.

On the first of August, we shipped a 40' sea-freight container from Louisville, Kentucky to Port Moresby. The largest bulk of the container was 300 sheets of drywall, which will complete three more classrooms, a hallway, and two school bathrooms. We were also able to ship 60 new desks and chairs for those new classrooms. One of the unexpected blessings came from one of Becky's high school classmates who now owns a book store. He asked us if we could use some children's books in the school, and the answer, of course, is a resounding YES! He organised two full pallets of children's books—approximately 2,400 books for our students!





When we finished loading the container, we had a little bit of space left over. Some friends let us use their Sam's Club membership and we were able to load up paper plates for "Transformed By the Gospel Youth Camp." It looks like we have enough plates, cups, and spoons for the next two years of camp.



Last week, I attended a week-long aviation course at JAARS, where some of the best flight instructors in the world spent time investing in me and our ministry. I'm very thankful for guys like Dan, Geoff, and Scott (who spent about 8 hours in a cockpit honing my skills) who made that possible.

Next week, we drop Ariel off at college, and the following week we return home to Papua New Guinea. Thank you for being such a large part of the ministry there. It's because of you that we are able to be there.
