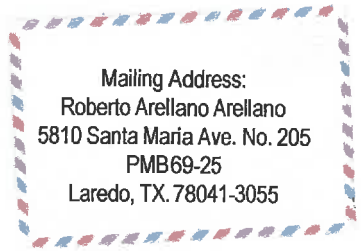

In two weeks, I have an appointment to undergo an echocardiogram as to evaluate my heart's condition. God never ceases to amaze us and I am so thankful because God supplied the resources to cover the medical expenses through some Churches and friends. As of now, we have \$1,000 Dollars left to pay of medical expenses.

The new Mission is doing great! We were able to finish the foundation and everything is ready for the walls to go up. However, the Doctor has advised me to wait a little long before I can start any heavy labor.
