There were many blessings as well as challenges there at MetroView Baptist Church while I pastored their church. We had a candle light service the Sunday before Christmas.



The day after Christmas, I moved from Antipolo to LaLoma, Q.C. which is a 30 minute drive but it takes, sometimes, 3 hours because of traffic. The following day I flew to Hong Kong China with Pastor & Mrs. Toquero, pastor of LaLoma Baptist Church, to hold services with a Chinese church and a Filipino church with nothing but domestic workers from the Philippines.

These are ladies who have left their husbands and children to earn more money abroad. We were able to teach them how to get their money from God while in the Philippines, without leaving their families.

I returned to Alabama on January 15th. for medical appointments and will be returning to the Philippines, the Lord willing, the first of May. I have a greater purpose there than here in the United States and that is where God has called me to serve Him since 1980. My heart is there.

"What can we do for you?" you may ask. "Please, please **pray** for my safety and health. **Pray** for the power of God to be on me as I preach to those who sit under my voice. **Pray** that the unsaved will be saved by the grace of God and **pray** that Christians will get revived and serve God. **Pray** that God will give me a caregiver to assist me. **Pray** for the Pastors and Worker Camp that will be held in May. **Pray** for me as I relieve a Pastor while he is away for 3 to 4 months in Cainta Rizal, west of Manila. **Pray** as I go up to Banaue, where the Rice Terraces are, to work in a mountain town, to do evangelistic work.
