Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ:

Bad News: I ended 2018 and began 2019 with pneumonia. In December, following 12 days of antibiotics, the doctor declared me cured! Ok, that was December. The 15th of January x-rays showed that I had another bout with pneumonia. This time it hit hard, and the doctor prescribed more antibiotics. Following treatment, he sent me home and required me to stay at home for two more weeks, for I was not recovering my strength. Finally, I am “back in service”. We have had several regular heart exams, and the doctor is pleased with the tests. He said my heart should be good for another 30 years. I am almost back to full strength.

Due to the treatments, I was unable to make the trip to the Bible Institutes. Therefore Pr. Joel and Pr. Edilson left me behind and took Pr. Leland, a new friend that lives in Salvador, to teach in my place. In May, Hódes and I will return to teach a class and in July we will hold our second graduation in Nova Holanda. We had planned on the graduation being our last trip.

Great News: The church will be continuing the Bible Institute. They have 16 adults that desire to begin classes. The leadership talk with Pr. Joel and Edilson about the possibility of us working with them. They want us to set up a study program, teach twice a year instead of every two months, and help them choose teachers for the other classes. As I said, this was not in our plans, but following prayer, we decided to help them since we are seeing progress and the church will be assuming responsibility.



Greater News: One of the greatest experiences is to see the birthing of a new church. Last year we helped in a massive effort to plant a new work in Coité, BA. Over 200 of us gathered to do evangelism, offer Bible Studies, and do some social work. The work has produced. Roberto, the man in charge of the mission, he is doing a tremendous job.

Last night I returned from our 12-hour drive from Retirolandia, about 10 miles from Coité. Again, we spent 4 days in the city. The groups covered the city with tracts, evangelizing, and offering Bible Studies. I have not heard the official numbers, but over 200 people want to do Bible Studies. Anderson and Bruna, that did intern with me in Caruaru, will lead this new work. I will be returning in April to help in the teaching of the Bible Studies and to preach a Bible Conference for Roberto in Coité. It is our desire to help them every two months.

ANSWERED PRAYER: We have asked you to pray with us about our future. After a year of prayer, we believe God wants us to remain, for the present time, in Pernambuco and help establish churches and strengthen the churches and pastors we are presently helping. The mission in Jd. Piedade will be one of our priorities this year.
