My head-aches are gone! I'm back to thinking clearly and my memory has (mostly) returned. I still have moments where I read something I've written, and I don't remember writing that; however, I'm going to start chalking that up to being past 40 years old.

We were able to complete the Bible Distributions in all of the Primary Schools in our area, and it was a great opportunity to be in the villages all through our area, while being given the invitation to speak to their children directly. Some of the villages were in locations where we could drive to; three of the villages required full day trips on small boats. Many of you have been a part of the BIMBI Bible Project here in PNG, and I can attest to the fact that it is having an impact in the lives of young people here. In fact, today, we have a youth event going on at our church, and there are teenagers who will be attending today because they met us for the first time when we gave them a Bible last month!



Every day, I have the privilege of discipling seven men here. They all come to work at the Christian School in some capacity, whether it is as a bus driver or as a groundskeeper. We start each day with thirty minutes of expository walking through the Scriptures, and I'm watching as God grows these men.



Next month, we will be holding our annual Youth Camp. We call it "Transformed by the Gospel" and this year, we have Evangelist Kwame Selver coming from the Bahamas. He will also be teaching a separate Disciple-Making Class for several churches in the area. We look forward to spending time with him and having him invest in the lives of our young people, and in the churches in the area. We already have 72 campers confirmed for this year. Six of those will be coming from Kotidanga and will walk for three days to get here! That is an amazing demonstration that they care about investing in their own spiritual walk.
