Serving in Latin America

A few ways you could pray for us:

1. Moving and set-up expenses. Our flights and luggage to Chile cost **\$3,000** for the five of us.

The cost of the furnishings, appliances, beds, and furniture is **\$5,800**. The cost of the car is **\$5,200**. We estimate that purchasing the items through the family will save us approximately twelve thousand dollars.

2. Visas. Pray that we can obtain religious visas. They would allow us to secure visas before we arrive in Chile. Many of the Chilean consulates in America work reduced hours, so there is no guarantee this can be accomplished before we move. If we can't get the religious visas, we will enter Chile on tourist visas and begin the process of obtaining a semi-permanent resident visa.

Dear Friends and Supporters,

This year has been full of disappointments, yet God has given us great times of rejoicing. Tara and I were discouraged in the spring, wondering if we would lose all of our support or be indefinitely stuck in the USA. Would we ever be able to accomplish what we believe God has called us to do?

Time after time, God has shown His care and plans for us. He often used His people and His church to encourage and support us. Thank you for being sensitive to the Holy Spirit and helping us along this journey!

This is the most exciting update we have penned so far on our missions' journey. After much prayer, confusion, and impatience about what our future might hold, we now know what God prepared for us. The country of Chile has opened its borders! We had started praying for and considering alternate fields for language school. God answered that prayer! Though we will say good-bye to our families, we are so excited to finish our pre-field ministry and make the move to South America.

God has opened the door for us to go to Chile. We plan to move to Chile on February 2, 2021. An American family living in Santiago, Chile is moving back to the U.S. They are willing to sell us their car and all the furnishings in their house. The landlord is willing to rent us the same house at a very reasonable rate. This will save us a great deal of money and help us with our mandatory quarantine once we arrive. Once we fly into Chile, we can walk right into a furnished home.

Lastly, I have one of the most exciting updates of all. Our oldest daughter, Taylor asked Jesus to save her! For the past few months we have talked to Taylor about Jesus and the Gospel.

She has asked some incredibly insightful and, even, difficult questions for us to answer. My favorite question was, "Dad, do we like the Devil?" I replied, "No, the Devil is our enemy." She thought hard for a few moments and then responded. "Doesn't Jesus tell us to love our enemies? Shouldn't I love the Devil even if he is my enemy?" I wondered what Tara's and my parents must have endured raising know-it-alls! :-)
