First of all, we would like to start our letter by Wishing you all a **MERRY CHRISTMAS & HAPPY YEAR**. We count it a privilege to be one of your missionaries and be partners together in sharing the gospel in the land of Mexico.

We are so thankful for each one of our supporting churches, that month after month you give so faithfully, so we can go and do the work God has called us to do.

One thing I can say throughout these 44 years as missionaries, "IT HAS BEEN WORTH IT ALL" and one day when this life is over, you will be able to see all the fruits of your giving to Missions.

I know that you will agree with me, that this year has been a very different year. This Pandemic has turned our plans upside down. But I can say this, that my wife and I have learned to accept the plans God has for us; He is in control and nothing is going to happen that He doesn't allow it to happen. So, we take it one day at a time, and pray for Gods protection.

We ask you to pray for our health. The month of January I will be having some procedures done on my esophagus because of Achalasia and they will be going in with a balloon dilation to stretch it out. So please pray that everything will go well, that they can fix the problem without surgery, and soon I can get back to normal again. I didn't know that getting old was so interesting!

All of the churches are doing great, many of our pastors and their families have had Covid, and some are fighting it this week, but God has protected them through it all. The cases here in Monterrey are worse every day, this past week we had over 890 new cases every day. The Government closed all the stores and churches on the weekend, so our churches have their Sunday services on Monday nights. It's a blessing to see that even through these hard times, souls are being saved and baptized.

This past month, God supplied the money, and we were able to put the roof on the second floor of one of our churches up in the mountains with the Nahuatl Indians. Even in the middle of the hard times, Gods work keeps going on.

At this moment we are praying God will supply for the tile floor for one of our Churches in Monterrey, Macedonia Baptist Church. We still lack 2,500.00 to finish it. Pray that God will supply for this special need.

We want to thank each one of you for your prayers and your faithful support. It makes it so much easier for the Missionary, when he has churches that pray and holds the rope so we can take the gospel to others. Please keep us in your prayers and may the Lord richly bless you is our prayers.
