Dear Pastor and Congregation,

We are thankful for all your prayers. We were able to get our car registered after a lot of controversy. We had to talk with the head of the traffic police who gave us an exception to the rules so we could use our car. We have settled back into things and are working on some projects for the coming months.

The English School

The English classes are currently on hold indefinitely due to Covid-19. We are watching the universities here closely. They are currently meeting virtually. When the universities go back to live classes, we will restart our classes as well. In the meantime, we are planning to start an English Bible club with some of our past students. This will allow us to stay in contact and provide another avenue to get the Gospel out. We will practice English while discussing passages of scripture. Please pray for souls to be saved through this.

Weekly Bible Study

Our Bible study group has been meeting for a month now. We were not sure how many would want to come back with the pandemic and all, but we were pleasantly surprised by the positive response to restarting the meetings. We have had between ten and fifteen people attending the meetings. There is a mix of saved and unsaved that attend. We are continuing with the Gospel of John. It is a great study for pointing people to Jesus. Please pray that we can find more unsaved people to invite to the meetings and that more souls will be saved.

Familiar Faces

One of the concerns we had when we went on furlough was for those who we had been working with prior to leaving. We thank God for His faithfulness. Katya was baptized shortly before we left and has remained faithful to church services while we were gone. Yulya was a student of Helen's who got saved, was faithful to discipleship classes for a while, but fell off. She is now faithfully attending church services again. Max is a young man who is not saved yet but has shown great interest in the Bible and has been faithful to our Friday night Bible study. Max was most anxious to start the Bible study again and has come to church services twice since we have been back. This past Sunday as I looked over at the three of them during the services, it was such a blessing to see how the Lord is working in their hearts. Please continue to pray for them!

We will apply for our residency permits in early April. Please pray for the process to go smoothly and that we can receive our permits on time with no problems.
