There was only three channels that you could get on the TV and then I don't remember exactly which channel it was on, but the program was called "I Remember Mama". It was a program of a mother being remembered by their children for the great impact she had made on their lives. Recalling that, I remember my Mama and I wish there was enough space in the newsletter to remember my mother to you for the things that she had done for us three children. My mom's dad died when she was a very young girl and she had to take over the responsibilities of cooking and cleaning the house before she was even 12 years old so her mother and seven brothers could get out and work in the fields. Mama's family, from almost sun up to sundown, picked cotton or tobacco for a living. We (Mama, dad and us 3 kids) were sharecroppers so didn't have a lot of today's means but Mama always pointed us kids in the right direction and tried to teach us right from wrong. My 2 siblings learned that lesson. I didn't learn too well. I had to pay the consequences but I remember Mama and what I remember most about Mama is that her wayward son was getting more wayward every day and she began earnestly to pray that her son would get saved and on March 3, 1968, God answered Mama's prayers. Today I'm writing to you in remembrance of Mama because Mama prayed. Mama knew how to get hold of God and I would like to say to all of the Mamas out there that have sons that are not where they should be don't give up praying. God is still on the throne. If your mother is still on the earth you should go out of your way to thank Mama for all that she did for you. I miss my Mama. I miss calling Mama to say "Happy Mother's Day" but she's with the Lord and one day very soon now I'll be able to join her but until then I just want to be found faithful to my calling to go to Haiti to win those people to the Lord Jesus Christ all because Mama prayed. So, to all of you mothers out there that will receive this newsletter, I love you and I thank you from the bottom of my heart for the things that you did for your family. A short update on the Wall family . . .

Mme Wall has been upgraded from the walker to a walking cane and she is doing very well with the cane and I am very blessed that so far, I have not been attacked with the cane. She does have a very important medical appointment for 26 May. I would ask you to pray much for the doctor that he would have wisdom to find the problem and be able to quickly correct the problem. As for myself I am beginning to get full strength back into my lungs from the battle that I had with the Covid as long as I do not over exert myself. My legs are very steady. My biggest problem is my smell and my taste have not come back yet. Other than that, we are in great shape for the shape we are in.

Haiti still has major problems with an increase in kidnappings, murders and robberies. The Haiti travel advisory from the US government is still a category 4 which simply means "do not go to Haiti" and it appears that it is not going to be lifted anytime soon so we need much prayer that will change. We have four teams that are ready to come to Haiti and help us and to be a blessing to our people but we cannot bring them in under a category 4 travel advisory. Bible School graduation is scheduled for the middle of November, so I ask you to pray for that as well. The graduates are getting really excited about graduation they have been a super great bunch of people. I'm thankful that you have prayed for me and those that taught as we attempted to instill in the students Biblical doctrines and "how to load the gospel gun and pull the trigger", as we were taught in Bible School.

Due to the Covid lockdown we were unable to hold Missionary Candidate School last year in person but this year the MCS will be held the week following Father's Day (June 21-25). Please make that a big matter of prayer as we have new missionary candidates coming in as well as veteran missionaries that will be home on furlough and will be bringing a challenge to the new candidates.

Joyce and I would like to thank each and every one of you for your faithful prayers and financial support through the years. You have been absolutely super! You have allowed us to be your missionary arm in the Republic of Haiti to fulfill the great commission. May God bless each and every one of you! Come see us when you will. We'll leave a light on for you "if we have electricity." Looking forward to seeing you soon. Here there or in the AIRRRRRRRRRR.
