With these thoughts in mind we want to share with you what has been going on in our lives since we last wrote you. Back in May we received our schedule for the reopening of classes of WBCM for June 21. We were excited to think that once again we would be involved in teaching the college classes. But by June 1, we went into lockdown again because of so many new positive cases of COVID. The hospitals are full and there have been many deaths here in Dipolog alone, not to mention the other municipalities.

In fact at the moment we are writing this letter we have a yellow caution tape across our gate. As of June 7 we had swab tests because we weren't feeling well. We were positive for COVID. Our journey into the viral world of COVID began. God guided us to make the decision to stay at home and find some private nurses to give us the care we needed in going through the COVID. We knew between care and medicines that it would be quite expensive, but we knew that was the way God was leading. God gave us two qualified nurses, experienced with COVID, to come and stay in our home and monitor our vital signs. It has been an opportunity also to share the gospel with the nurses. Neither has accepted Christ, but we are still praying for their salvation.

Ladies from the church graciously gave their time to make meals for us and drop them by at the gate daily. We are truly blessed to have a church family who love us. We are now well into recovery of the virus. We are making improvements every day. We praise the Lord for His watchful care and protection for us. On June 28 we will have our rcptr test to clear us and tell us that the virus is gone. Our prayer is there will be no error. We will receive our result on Tuesday, and then providing we are negative, we will begin sanitizing the house. It has been recommended that we proceed with vaccinations providing we have negative results.

When people say it is impossible for this or for that, it is God's opportunity to work and show His power. He has done that in every situation through this journey of COVID. God has reminded us many times that when we are weak, He is strong. We ask for your continued prayers for healing and recovery from COVID.
