Greetings to each and every one of you from the United States of America! Yes, GEORGE and I are still here but thanks to your prayers she got a good report from the doctor and we're hoping that we get a good report from the surgeon on the 28th of this month and she'll be released and we can go home if we can get into Home as you very well know our president was assassinated on Wednesday and his wife was severely injured and was airlifted to Miami and is expected to recover. The surgeon says it's going to be a long drawn out affair but she is expected to recover. Their son, who also was shot, sustained a non-life-threatening injury. I received word this past week that the new interim president had requested 500 US soldiers to help secure the infrastructure of Haiti such as the dams, the road, the communication systems to chase telephone and internet but Mr. Biden denied it so looks like they're on their own. They requested help from the UN. The word I received was the UN said no also, so we'll see where it goes from there under the leadership of the new interim president. The police and the military knocked out one gang that has been a sore spot for a long long time. The ones that they did not eliminate they put them in prison until they can bring them before the judge – we'll see how well that goes. As a result of the assassination all of the port of entry were closed for 15 days while they round up those responsible for the assassination of which, strangely enough, two of them were US American citizens. Reportedly there were 28 perpetrators - most of those came from the country of Colombia some came out of Australia. Contact was made with Missionary Flights and they were approved to fly in on Thursday and the word is that they are free to travel back-and-forth on regular flight days which means the 15 day restriction has been lifted. American Airlines is also now flying back into Port a Prince. "ntd.com" has a couple of interesting articles or you may type "Haiti assassination" into your search engine as the internet is overflowing with lots of news. I received a call from Wisnert in Pignon this past Wednesday and we had 294 new cases of Covid reported in the area this past weekend. I have not been able to confirm it's just the report that I got from somebody that supposedly is very much in tight with the health department. Anyway whatever it is, it is not good so we'll see as the Covid is increasing and is spiking quite heavily.

As a result of the assassination EVERYTHING, food, construction material, and in the moment there is no gas or diesel available. Wisnert did report that everything was A-OK on the property and with him and the kids in the orphanage grocery. Thanks for praying. We will keep you informed as we continue to get information out of Haiti. Hope to see you soon, here, there, or in the air.
