I trust that you're all doing well especially in this chaotic day and time in which we live. It has been an exhausting two months since we last wrote to you. We really want to thank you for your faithfulness to us, the surprise love gifts that you sent and especially for all of your prayers. We will try to bring you up-to-date on what's happening with FRED and Joyce Wall as well as what's happening in Haiti of which you are most likely much aware of if you own a television. Mme Wall is making great strides in recovery from her fall resulting in the broken hip and top of her femur bone. She's beginning to get her balance back somewhat. She is making great inroads using the walking cane to maintain her balance. Please keep praying for her to "master it". As for myself (Fred) hey 🍌 I'm in great shape for the shape I'm in and praise the Lord for His goodness and blessings and that due to y'all's prayers. My trip back to Haiti was uneventful. We did not accomplish all that we wanted to accomplish but the depot wall that split from top to bottom from the earthquake, we were able to get repaired and it really looks good even if I was the contractor doing the work. 😊 The other good news is we were able to verify that there was no damage done to our cisterns from the earthquake. We have had sufficient rain to fill both of the large cisterns and after inspecting all the other buildings they all seem to be intact. Again, we owe that to you praying that the Lord would hold everything together because He did do that for us. Our time with the pastors and the people was very precious only short-lived. Looking forward to returning hopefully September or October. We would appreciate you praying to that end that it will be safe enough to go in and attempt to repair whatever damage has been done to the internet system that we might get our surveillance cameras back online so that we might know what's going on at the property and around the buildings in our absence. Due to the gang control in the major cities the cost of living in Haiti has doubled or may have tripled. Our people are really hurting. The cost of putting the kids in school and the cost of feeding the kids has more than doubled. It seems the gangs know when a truckload of food is leaving the big cities coming up into the plateau area and they are hijacking the trucks and stealing all the food, even in some cases shooting the driver of the truck. There is no gas or diesel fuel available at the pumps. They are threatening the gas station if they pump any gas they will set the station on fire. As for the tanker trucks leaving the storage facilities, they are told if they pull the truck out of the storage facilities they will set them on fire. Businesses are scared to open because of not knowing what the gangs will do. For a short time there was a gang truce but that seems to have been short-lived.

The presidential election and the governmental elections have been postponed until sometime in 2022 and it does not take a rocket scientist to know what that means and it is clearly evidenced by the city of Port au Prince; anarchy controls the country.

With the assassination of the president of Haiti many of the hierarchy in the government have quit for fear. Consequently, customs now has no controllers and they can charge whatever they want to and do. There appears to be never ending top stories on the political situation in Haiti, the results of the earthquake and the hurricane. At last count we had over 2,200 dead and many times that number injured. Simply go to your search engine for the internet and just type the word "Haiti" and you can download the stories. Should you be one of those who do not have a computer or the internet and you wish for us to send you links linking you to some of the top stories simply send us an email - we will be happy to do that for you. Again, thank you for your faithfulness to us and when we do get back home come see us. We will leave a light on for you if we have electricity. Trusting the Lord to see you soon. Here, There or in the AIRRRRRRR!!
