In the past several weeks, we have been on a rollercoaster of emotions and experiences, from funerals to new ministry outreach, that can only be described as God doing His bidding in His time and preparing us more and more for His return.

Recently we were invited to a Vacation Bible School at Lewisburg Baptist Church, Pastor Jonathan Comer in West Virginia. They had several Hispanic children coming to the activity and needed help with translation. Seven weeks later we have been meeting at the church with these children and their parents starting up a new Hispanic outreach at this church! We are so excited to see how God brings people together to do His work! We are planning on being here till October 4 when we return to Florida and then Costa Rica if everything related to restrictions stays as is. Please pray for this new Hispanic ministry and the leadership at LBC as they work and minister to these people.

As of now things in Costa Rica are about the same. Recently they lifted the weekend vehicle restrictions only to reinstate them two weeks later. What is frustrating about this is trying to keep the church informed and engaged when these changes are announced. Most of the time it takes weeks for a church to shift directions when schedules and activities are involved. As many of you know, the use of a yearly calendar has become quite useless these days. Pray for our staff and congregation that God will continue to give us fruit despite all the restrictions. We do rejoice in the baptism of one new family and the celebration of Independence Day that was well attended with visitors. We also rejoice in the continued stability of the Seminary and the commitment of our current student body.

On September 28 Mom (Maria White) will be travelling back to Costa Rica and re-engaging with her usual responsibilities. Recently my brother missionary Sam White lost the piano player at their church due to the family relocating to Mexico. Mom is looking forward to stepping in. After all, this has been part of her life's ministry and she loves doing it. Please continue to keep her in your prayers. October 24 will mark one year since Dad passed away, and it still is very difficult for her. Thank you for keeping her in your prayers and staying with her regarding financial support. It has been a real blessing and relief for all our family.

Finally, I ask you to pray for Julie. The week she started college she got Covid! What a race that was to get her basic care and meds! Thank God she recovered quickly and was able to return to normal within 8 days. Liberty had a big outbreak with their freshmen class and had to lock down for a couple of weeks. We were blessed to be going through there after the fact and stopped to check on her and make sure she had what she needed. Please pray that she can learn and adapt to all the new college life experiences and honor God above all things.

We love and appreciate all our ministry partners. We pray for you daily and ask that God would give you much wisdom to work through all the issues of these ever-changing times.
