Becky and I made a quick trip to the States in May. I haven't done the math, but I think that we were traveling to get there and back for more hours than we were actually there. Jet-lag followed us for about three weeks, but it was such a privilege to watch Ariel graduate from Pensacola Christian College.

Two days before we began our trip back to PNG, my dad called me with a problem on our standby generator. We have a 60kva generator that provides backup power when the city's power goes out (which is an almost daily occurrence). We were able to rush order the voltage regulator from California to Florida and received it just hours before we flew back to PNG. Then, hours after arriving in PNG, the part was installed into the generator and we are back up and running. In a city where the temperatures come all the way down to 75 degrees in

the winter (which started yesterday), we really appreciate the ability to turn on air conditioners and ceiling fans.

Hannah is studying theatre at Bob Jones University, and she is spending her summer with us here. She wrote a play called "A New Song." The play follows the life of Christ and is a clear presentation of the Gospel. There is a little artistic license; but there is a part of the production where a little boy takes Jesus off the cross. That grabs me every time I watch them practice. This weekend, they will present the four times. We are thankful to see the Lord doing a work in and through Hannah.



It has been a season of salvations over the last two weeks. In the ministries here, between the school and the church, we have seen 15 people put their trust in the Lord Jesus. Several of them are people for whom we have been praying for a long time. These seasons are not the norm; however when they come, they are a great reminder that He is always at work, even in the dry seasons. This too is fruit to your account. Thank you.
