Dear Family, Friends, and Supporting Pastors,

“FOR THE LORD is Good; His mercy is everlasting; and His truth endureth to all generations.” Psalm 100:5. Truly the Lord is good, and as we have safely arrived in the States as of May 9, to begin our medical furlough, we have experienced His goodness, and His mercy. We know, and stand on the fact, that His truth endureth to all generations even when this decade in which we live does not want to accept it.

We have enjoyed being with our children and grandchildren and friends. We have begun our medical check-ups. All along we have been praying for God to give us answers and we believe He has already begun to reveal some things to us through those medical check ups. Two years ago you might recall, I was hospitalized while we were still in the Philippines, with what was diagnosed as rapid heart rate. There were plenty of tests, I was given medicine, and was sent home assuming everything was normal at that time. It was already in the back of our minds that this would eventually need to be addressed during furlough. On June 2, we began our medical “wellness check-up” with our family doctor. It appeared that the rapid heart rate returned right then and there before we left the doctors office. I was sent immediately to the ER at the heart hospital. So for 2 days they did tests and tried to balance medications to remedy the problem. What they finally found out was that I had “aflutter” in my heart and that an “aflutter ablation” procedure could take care of the problem. So we proceeded scheduling the procedure. With the procedure completed on June 14, I began to recover when I experienced very heavy breathing so we went back to the ER where they found that there was water in my lungs which is quite common after this procedure. I have recovered and the medicines seem to be effective. All in all, the doctor said my heart is in good condition.

Beth’s diabetes is well under control, and all other issues related to her diabetes will be addressed in appointments coming up later this month and next, along with the follow-ups on my heart procedure and meeting with the cardiologist before we begin traveling.

We are hoping to begin scheduling meetings in August and the following year, so if you have any preference as to when you want us to come to your church, please let us know.
